President's Message

"YE ARE THE LIGHT OF THE WORLD"

As a personal representative of the Lord Jesus Christ you have been a participant in His great work. This past year, we as a mission set high goals along with action items to strive for 1998. Congratulations in achieving and exceeding those goals.

We appreciate your hard work, diligence and greater obedience which has brought forth an abundance of blessings from the Lord. As obedience has increased the Lord has provided many more opportunities to teach, baptize, and magnify our calling. In 1998, we exceeded our goal of baptizing 1800 people and in ten of the twelve months, set new monthly mission records. November we reached what seemed for so many years to be "the impossible dream" of baptizing two-hundred souls unto the fold of Christ" (we actually baptized 213). We all felt the joy described by Ammon: "... I do not boast in my strength, nor my own wisdom; but behold, my joy is full yea, my heart is brim with joy, and I will rejoice in my God. Yea, I know that I am nothing; as to my strength I am weak; therefore I will not boast of myself but I will boast of my God, for in his strength I can do all things ... " (Alma 26:11,12). We salute you and express the congratulations from the Utah North Area Presidency on your achievements.

We reflect at this time on the special opportunities we have had to be together as a mission to hear the words of today's prophets. This year we had the great privilege to be with our Prophet Gordon B. Hinckley and Elder Henry B. Eyring at Regional Conference. We were again blessed to be able to be taught by Elder Eyring in the Ogden Temple chapel, dressed all in white, hearing the Lord's voice through His servant. Elder Eyring promised that if we serve with all diligence and in complete obedience as missionaries our sins would be forgiven. President Hinckley told us of the urgency of our labors, he also challenged us to stand a little taller and be a little better in all that we do. At the Christmas Devotional, we were privileged to meet and be taught by Elder Jeffrey R. Holland. Elder Holland reminded us that being the Lord's representative is the greatest work we can do.

He also admonished us that we will make or break our mission between the hours of 6:00 a.m. to 9:00 a.m. every day.

We will never in this lifetime know the extent of our influence through our righteous labors. How one baptism can change not just one life but the life of many. In his first area, Elder Butler, one of our newer missionaries met Bishop Bruce Cowley. Bishop Cowley 38 years ago served a mission in England. He felt that he was less than successful because he had only baptized two people during his entire mission. His two converts were taught and baptized in his last month while in the field. He had worked hard and been very obedient his entire mission and in the last month was led by the Spirit to Elder Butler's grandparents. Those two baptisms have led to 30 of the immediate family becoming members of the church. How many hundreds of lives will be affected by Elder Butler and the rest of his family who have or will serve missions?

This next year will be a remarkable red-letter year. We close out not only the century, but mark the beginning of another millennium. What goals will you set and accomplish this new year? After all, "ye are the light of the world"...therefore, "let your light so shine before men, that they may see your good works, and glorify your father which is in heaven." (Matthew 5:14,16) In D&C 128:22, the Prophet Joseph Smith issues a challenge for this mission; "...shall we not go on in so great a cause, go forward and not backwards, courage... and on, on to victory; let your hearts rejoice, be exceedingly glad. Let the earth break forth into singing...let the mountains shout for joy...until the wonders of your eternal king!...let us, therefore, as a church and a (mission) a people, and as Latter-day Saints, offer unto the Lord an offering in righteousness..." (D&C 128:22-25).

We appreciate you in all you do to push the Lord's work forward at a greater pace.

elect. The missionaries were persistent in calling, stopping by, and leaving notes at Stacey's house for 2 weeks. One evening, they finally caught her home. They sat under the maple tree in her front yard and began the first discussion. Although she had no religious background, Stacey agreed to pray about Joseph Smith with them. As Stacey prayed, she was seized by a dark, evil feeling and was not able to speak. She felt as if her tongue was bound. Stacey didn't know what this feeling was but she did know that it was horrible and never wanted to feel it again. Looking at the sisters, Stacey fought with these feelings. Unsure of how to express them she reflected back and shared feelings of peace experienced earlier. When the discussion was finished, Stacey ran into the house, and replayed the experience to her husband. Concerned, Scott said, Well, honey, I don't know what it is either, but it sounds like you'd better stay away from those Mormons.

Because of Stacey's frightening feelings while praying, she avoided the missionaries. She truly wondered why such a dramatic experience happened and wanted to understand. After 2 weeks she agreed to talk with the missionaries again. Stacey opened up and expressed her concerns and experience and wanted an explanation. They were able to resolve her concerns by reading the Joseph Smith experience—one very similar to her own. This brought great comfort to her, and she continued to listen to the discussions and learn more about the Gospel. She felt good about what she was learning and realized that Satan was trying to halt her progression. Stacey was baptized September 13, 1998.

Stacey's older brother, Eric Willis, came to her baptism. He came simply to support her. Eric was approached and welcomed by many people there. He was also approached by Mike Victor and the missionaries (surprise!!!) and was invited to hear the discussions. We continued to keep in touch with him over the next several weeks. In the meantime, Stacey's 10 year old daughter, Noel, took the discussions and was baptized on September 29, 1998. Eric attended Noel's baptism also and felt the spirit during the Holy Ghost Dialog and was visibly touched. Eric and his 8 year old daughter, Kassi, had the first discussion at a member's home and (of course), opposition was experienced. The elect member kept; stating, "I feel REALLY

uncomfortable--I just- feel so uncomfortable." The missionaries decided to wait, for now, to pray until another time. The end of the first discussion and the second discussion were taught at, Eric's in-laws house. They are very active members and were thrilled to help out. We invited both Kassi and Eric to be baptized at the end of the second discussion. Kassi immediately replied, "YES! I will". Eric asked if he could be baptized like Jesus, in a river and then said, "I don't, know, girls, but I'll think about, it,... I'm just, nervous." We asked him, "Eric, what are you so nervous about" He replied, "All this." He was concerned about, being able to actually live the Gospel and keep the necessary commandments. But we knew early on that Eric had integrity and was ready, he just needed a little time and confidence. Just, as he told us about his concerns Kassi, pointing at her dad in a very firm, loud voice stated, "Dad, Grandma and Grandpa are here!" He looked over at her and said "Kassi, what did you say that for?" both of his parents died-his father when he was 5 years old and his mother when he was a teenager. So these were to people that Kassi had never seen or talked with before. She then got teary eved and said "I don't, know daddy, but, they are here." As she did, we both had the most incredible feeling at the same time, one that we have never experienced at any time before, not even in the temple. We felt, like we were surrounded in a bubble of light inside and out. We each felt a whoosh through our entire bodies head to toe and the most calm, peaceful feeling stayed. We absolutely knew, without a doubt, that Eric's parents were truly in the room with us. Eve balls bulging out, of our heads we said, "Whoa, they are really here! Eric was scared and wanted to run out of the house understandably so. This was a very new experience for us all. We left and he didn't sleep a single wink all night long. We talk with him the next morning and explained that he was special and was being watched over very closely. We told him it, was a really cool thing that happened -a very special Experience.

Eric and Kassi both continued to progress together and started living the teachings of the Gospel. Kassi was baptized on October 24, 1998. Eric gave the talk on the Holy Ghost and said "Kassi, I'm not, really sure what you want me to say. But having the Holy Ghost means that you're never alone and you always have a friend. 
