While we were teaching this family, my companion and I received a referral from a family we had dinner with one night. The girl's name was Jennifer Richards. Her mother was a non-member but really wanted Jennifer to be taught. We called her the next day and set up an appointment.

One day while teaching the Cameron family, they said that they had someone for us to teach. Her name was Lizette Richards, she was Sister Cameron's sister. She had three children, Jennifer, James and Robert who were old enough to be baptized.

We set up a time to begin teaching the Richards' family at the Cameron's home and committed all of them to baptism. This spirit that is in both of these families was amazing. I wish I had the words to describe it.

Another thing that happened, was one night while teaching the Cameron's, their non-member sister who lives with them sat in on the discussion. I talked to her after the discussion, gave her a Book of Mormon and set up a time to teach her. She accepted at first, but later changed her mind. Nevertheless, with the spirit that is in that house, I know it won't be long before she is taught and baptized.

The Cameron's have set a goal to be sealed together as a family in the next couple of months. Brother and Sister Cameron are taking the Temple Prepara-

tion class and Brother Cameron will be receiving the Melchizedek Priesthood very soon. I must say that this is truly one of the most incredible experiences I have had on my mission so far.


