
CONVERSION STORIES

They sat in on his discussions. We taught them at the Ward Mission Leader's home. For the month we taught, Johnny read the scriptures, a change in this 58 year-old grouch began. He was kinder and more patient. His eyebrows weren't as heavy. His health got better, his language wasn't foul and he started to smile. The Spirit began to work in him and a change happened and he began to receive His image in his countenance. Our Heavenly Father sent his son, Christ, to save this man. Elder Wright and I were instruments in seeing it all happen. When he quit drinking and smoking, he was baptized. He came up out of the water with a smile from ear to ear, eyes drowning with tears. He expressed his love and thanks to his God verbally and spiritually. It was such a happy day. The night after his baptism we attended a small party. I walked into the kitchen and overheard he and his wife. He said to her, "Why is it that we're so happy, when just a few weeks ago we were filing for divorce?" She said, "You're becoming more of the man I want to be with for eternity. I excused myself and went to the bathroom and with tears in my own eyes, I offered a prayer of gratitude and I didn't every want to stop bringing this happiness into people's lives.
