Brother Alfredo Duarte agreed to meet with us and it wasn't until the appointment and during the meeting that we learned why they called him "El Profe." Brother Duarte was a teacher in his native country of Mexico. He had a lot of experience as a teacher, he was a very knowledgeable person in things of the world and of the scriptures. For almost 15 years the missionaries had tried so hard to help him reach the waters of baptism, but failing in each attempt. My testimony of the "Pray Now" tremendously increased after this experience, because as soon as we finished praying Brother Duarte had tears in his eyes. CONVERSION STORIES

As we were traveling to an appointment we were distracted by a truck that was being unloaded so we felt that we should stop and help. We found out that it was a part member couple and invited ourselves in and gave Scott and Brooke a few things to think about. We ended up teaching all of the discussions and then found out that Scott would be called to go to war in 3 days. We scheduled to eat at a member home with them. That night we committed Scott to be baptized that next day at 4:00 p.m. We had the font filled, programs ready but Scott was no where to be found. We found out that he was called that day at 9:00 a.m. to be ready by 1:00 p.m. to leave for Virginia for training. At the same time he found out that his wife was pregnant. His wife, Brooke ended up having complications. This gave Scott the opportunity of returning and again accepted the challenge to be baptized. He was a changed man after that day and looks forward now to being sealed for time and all eternity. Now my joy is full. Elder Hemming.

The most amazing conversion story I had on my mission occurred in my first area, Syracuse. It was my first month in the mission and my trainer and I had been working hard with out any success. We both really wanted to see someone baptized that first month together but nothing seemed to be working. We decided to turn it over to the Lord and leave it up to him. On May 30 we got a call from the President of Syracuse West Stake asking us to come and meet a man by the name of Chuck Deaver who wanted to be baptized. We went over immediately. Chuck was very "elect", and had been taught by the missionaries in the past. We reviewed the discussions with him, and he was baptized by his son the next day.

We got ready for bed that night and my companion pulled out his pocket knife and began to carve a small line in the back of his name tag. I asked, "What are you doing?. He responded by telling me that he put a dash in the back of his tag for every person he baptized. I pulled out my old leatherman and began to do the same with my tag, but as I stared down at that lone dash on my tag I realized that true conversion comes by the power of the Holy Ghost and that was what mattered most in Chuck's life. I look at that one dash on the back of my tag now and I realize I may not have had that much of an effect on Chuck's conversion to the Gospel, but his conversion made an immeasureable difference in the way I worked the rest of the mission, because I realized that it was the Holy Ghost that made all the difference. One of the most inspirational experiences happened this last week. It all started out with a member family picking up their newly released missionary from the airport. It was the Nelson family. While they were going home their son asked the parents who lived in a particular home. The answer was the Neaf family. The next question asked was "what do you know about them?" "Not much," was the parents response. The son replied, "Don't you think we should know them, we should bring them some cookies. The story goes, the whole family went over to deliver the treat to Neaf's home, whom they didn't even really know. The Neaf family invited the Nelson's into their home to visit. After the visit the Nelson's told the Neaf's they would like to have them come over and visit some time.

In the missionary world, myself and my companion had picked out a family from each ward to go and do member work with. Among the family's chosen, was the Nelson family. We stopped by their home and set up the member work appointment.

When we went over to do the member work, I was very impressed with their returned missionary son, who was persistent, but encouraging at the same time. The Neaf family was brought up and we extended an invitation. The family was extended a one week commit.

The Nelson family went through with their commitment and the teaching process began now that the finding was over.

The Neaf family consisted of Casey, the father who was less active; Lisa, the mother who wasn't a member; Colton, who was 7 and Trapper, who was 2 weeks old. When we started teaching them, we taught in different members homes. As we taught they started coming to church and keeping other commits. Lisa was very receptive and believed the things we taught, but her parents weren't in favor of the message of restoration. I believe that was what was holding her back. We taught for four months. then about a week and 1/2 ago we taught her about fasting and started a fast with her. The fast went great. We came by last Thursday and she had decided she wanted to be baptized. Lisa Neaf was baptized April 20, 2003, Easter Sunday. The Spirit was so strong, this was a great experience for me. Through this story of finding, teaching and baptizing there were many great principles taught, but just as our Mission Values state: "The Spirit is the Key." Elder Deason

I remember sitting with him on a rock the day his van was stolen. It was a Sunday, the same day he had decided to be baptized. "I'm going to pack my suitcases and take my family to Wyoming, but I'm still going the baptized today. Though they no longer live in Utah, he and his family are still faithful. Elder Puster
